



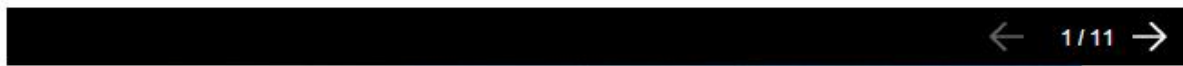

## *Algarrobo, Chile*

Located seaside in Algarrobo, Chile, San Alfonso del Mar Resort features the first navigable man-made lagoon. Covering 20 acres, the lagoon pool is more than half a mile long with a maximum depth of 115 feet (35 meters), and contains 66,000,000 gallons of water that is pumped, filtered, and treated from the Pacific Ocean. This man-made lagoon is also the largest lagoon in the world and holds the Guinness World Record for the biggest pool on Earth.

Surrounded by white sand beaches with the Pacific Ocean on the horizon, the crystalline lagoon offers guests a safe environment to practice a variety of recreational and water sporting activities such as kayaking, windsurfing, scuba, and snorkeling. Sunbathers and pool loungers will also appreciate the absence of waves and ocean currents, allowing them to float freely and without worry.
